Psychology Only Assessments:

- **Independent Psychological Evaluation (IPE):** (est. 15-20 hours) **\$235.00/hr**
Ph.D. Psychologist assessment, which may include diagnosis, treatment planning, and referral questions. Assessment Includes interview and a broad-range of psychometric measures.
- **Brief Mental Health Review:** (est. 4-5 hours) **\$235.00/hr**
Ph.D. Psychologist screen with general comments about possible restrictions, suggested treatment directions, and general referral questions. No diagnosis provided. Not appropriate for complex cases (will result in recommendation for IPE). Includes assessment interview and limited psychometric measures.

Multidisciplinary Assessments:

Team composition is based on the needs of the insurer/agency and client and may include the following health professionals: Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist, Medical (Physiatrist, Plastic Surgeon, Orthopedic Surgeon, Emergency Physician) and/or Ph.D. Psychology.

Assessment fees are dependent on the complexity of the assessment and the intensity of the contact time per team member. Kinetik prefers to convene assessment teams based on the specific needs of each case, ensuring efficiency and effectiveness.

Note: The function of an RCE is typically to assess a client who is assumed to be at maximum rehabilitation potential. These assessments are intended to include a disability determination and to define a client's residual function. RCEs differ from a standard Full Team Assessment in that they include a full Functional Capacity Evaluation and more extensive review of Activities of Daily Living from the OT. Psychology includes more extensive review and summary of file documents related to mental health.
